



STALLION BREEDING CONTRACT FOR TRANSPORTED SEMEN AND/OR ARTIFICIAL INSEMINATION

I the undersigned, (Mare Owner), hereby agree to breed the mare _____ to the stallion *CANAL LAURINSTON during the ____ breeding season. "Breeding season," for the purpose of this contract, is defined as April ____ through August, _____. This agreement covers the specific use of transported semen and/or artificial insemination with mare insemination accomplished by a licensed veterinarian. The stud fee of \$1,000.00 includes a non-refundable booking fee of \$150.00. If using transported semen, a deposit of \$400.00 must accompany this signed contract.

This service is subject to the following:

1. The entire stud fee, including booking fee, is due with this signed contract before semen is released and/or shipped. All shipped semen deposits are also due at this time as outlined in the transported semen fee schedule on the next page. Well in advance of semen shipment, it is imperative that Mare Owner and Stonybrook Connemaras agree upon a mutually convenient breeding date so that stallion will be available for collection. Once viable semen is shipped to the MareOwner, or his/her agent, the stud fee is non-refundable.
2. Stallion Owner agrees that if said stud fee is paid, and said mare, as a result of this breeding, does not have a live foal that can stand and nurse unassisted, the stud fee will be carried forward to the next breeding season ONLY. If the mare miscarries or aborts after her return home, Mare Owner has the privilege to return her for breeding during the current season or the following year ONLY. Thereafter, this contract will be deemed fulfilled. Once a live foal has been delivered, assisted or unassisted, that can stand and nurse unassisted, this contract is deemed fulfilled. Stallion Fee will not be refunded.
3. The stud fee will be carried forward, and the live foal guarantee is valid, only if the Mare Owner has properly maintained the health of the mare, and verifies the mare's pregnancy loss, stillbirth or newborn foal death by notifying the Stallion Owner by phone within 48 hours and sending a signed and dated veterinary certificate within 15 days, clearly stating the following:
 - a) Identification of the mare named herein
 - b) Verification of the loss of pregnancy or stillbirth
 - c) Verification that, in the veterinarian's best judgment, the mare was maintained in a reasonable state of health, including vaccinations and deworming and that monitoring of the mare at time of foaling was adequate enough to reasonably detect and attend to any foaling difficultiesIf Mare Owner fails to deliver the mare for rebreeding the following year, then any and all fees paid shall not be refundable; the right to rebreed is thereby cancelled and the Stallion Owner is released from any further obligation whatsoever.
4. If the mare is registered, a copy of her papers must accompany this contract to expedite completion of the stallion report. Mares must be in healthy and sound breeding condition. A health record of deworming, vaccinations and clean culture, (except maidens), must be provided to Stonybrook Connemaras prior to semen shipment.
5. A Stallion Certificate will be issued for a foal when all expenses have been received in full by Stonybrook Connemaras and mare owner requests it..
6. It is further agreed that should the above named stallion die or become unfit for service after the mare is pronounced safely in foal, the Stallion Owner is released from all further responsibility. If mare dies, or becomes unfit for breeding, the Mare Owner may return the following breeding season ONLY, without an additional stallion fee, with a substitute mare approved by Stallion Owner.
7. Before semen will be shipped for a mare to be bred by transported semen, Mare Owner must pay the transported semen deposit as outlined in the fee schedule on the next page. The costs of collection and shipping, as per fee schedule, will be deducted from the deposit and the remaining balance returned when no more shipments are needed for the current breeding season. **SHOULD MULTIPLE SHIPMENTS EXCEED THE DEPOSIT ON ACCOUNT, A FURTHER DEPOSIT OF \$400.00 MUST BE RECEIVED BY STONYBROOK CONNEMARAS BEFORE ANY FURTHER SHIPMENTS WILL BE MADE.**
8. Mare Owner understands that Lee Webster, Agent for Stonybrook Connemaras, must be notified the first day that said mare comes into season. Lee Webster, Blue Chip Stables, 4795 Acacia Way, Penngrove, CA 94951. (707) 794-9299. Call again twenty-four to forty-eight hours before you will need the stallion collected. **COLLECTIONS ARE MONDAYS, WEDNESDAYS AND FRIDAYS.** Federal Express overnight service will be used in most cases.
9. This contract is not transferable by Mare Owner. There will be no exceptions to the terms of this contract that are not provided for in writing and signed by both parties.
10. In the event that the Stallion Owner finds it necessary to institute legal action to enforce the terms of this contract, Mare Owner agrees to pay all reasonable attorney fees and court costs expended by Stallion Owner and/or Stonybrook Connemaras, through and including any judgments.
11. All the above being read, understood and agreed to by Mare Owner, Stonybrook Connemaras agrees to breed said mare during the ____ season.

LOSS OF EQUITAINER FEE	\$300.00

The Equitainer must be returned in good condition within four working days of shipment or there will be an extra charge of \$20.00 per day until it is returned. Federal Express, Airborne Express or UPS should be used, 2nd Day Air, to return the Equitainer as there have been damage problems in the past when other carriers have been used. ANY DAMAGE TO THE EQUITAINER IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE MARE OWNER.

Federal Express is the preferred mode of shipment.

A deposit of \$400.00, payable to Stonybrook Connemaras, must be received with this signed contract and stallion fee. Collection and shipping costs will be deducted from this deposit and the balance returned when no further shipments are required for the season. In the case of multiple shipments, if the collection and shipping costs exceed the deposit, then a further \$400.00 deposit will be required before semen can be shipped.
